

NMS 2017 Softball Tryouts

Any girl interested in trying out for the NMS Softball team, must turn in the permission slip below signed by a parent/guardian, and must have a current physical. If the slip or physical is not turned in before try outs they will not be allowed to try out for the team. Tryouts will be **here at NMS immediately following school.** Students may bring a change of clothes and any equipment they would like to bring that Monday morning. - Tryouts will be held as listed above. Practices will be Mon-Thurs until **4:00pm. (sometimes 4:30)** A practice schedule will be given. Players are to be picked up promptly at the proper time. (carpool is highly encouraged)
- Practices are to be held at both NMS and Zachary Youth Park. A practice and game schedule will be given.
- There are approximately 10-12 games per season, not including the jamboree and post season tournament. The start time for games is usually between 5:00-7:00. Parents will be responsible for getting their child to and from games. There will not be a bus provided for middle school to and from games. Again carpooling is highly recommended.
- Academics are priority here at NMS. Grades will be checked frequently and team members will be monitored on classroom performance as well as sportsmanship on the court.
- Repeated infractions or improper behavior during school or at practice can be grounds for dismissal from the team. This includes TOR/DC, HW clinic, Friday School, etc. Part of your job as a team member is to be a role model for other peers at NMS. The removal of a player from the team for any reason is up to the coach's discretion.
- Parents are expected to act as role models for our players. They are expected to support our teams by cheering them on from the stands. No trash talk or negative comments to players, officials, scorekeepers, coaches, or other parents will be tolerated during the games. If parents cannot represent themselves as NMS parents should they will be removed from the stands and banned from future contests.
