

NMS 7th and 8th Grade Girls Basketball Tryouts

Any 7th or 8th grade girl interested in trying out for the NMS basketball team must turn in a current physical and the permission slip below signed by a parent/guardian on or before **Monday, October 28, 2024**. If the physical or slip is not turned in before the deadline the student will not be allowed to try out for the team. - Tryouts will be held as listed above. Practices will be held after school until **4:00**. All players are expected to be picked up promptly at **4:00** from the NMS gym. There may be some weekend practices depending on the game schedule.
- Team members are expected to participate in all practices and games. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action from the Coaching staff, which may be, but is not limited to suspension from games or removal from the team.
- We will have approximately 10-20 regular season games this year. The start time for games is usually between 4:30 -7:00. Parents will be responsible for getting their child to and from games.
- Academics are priority here at NMS. Grades will be checked frequently, and team members will be monitored on classroom performance as well as sportsmanship on the court.
- Repeated infractions or improper behavior during school or at practice can be grounds for dismissal from the team. This includes TOR/DC, HW clinic, Friday School, etc. Part of your students' job as a team member is to be a role model for other peers at NMS. The removal of a player from the team for any reason is up to the coach's discretion.
- Parents are expected to act as role models for our players. They are expected to support our teams by cheering them on from the stands. No negative comments to players, officials, scorekeepers, coaches, or other parents will be tolerated during the games. If parents cannot represent themselves as NMS parents should, they will be removed from the stands and banned from future contests.
